



St Margaret's College Old Girls' Association Fees Assistance Scholarship Terms and Conditions

The St Margaret's College Old Girls' Association offers descendants of Old Girls two senior school Fee Assistance Scholarships. These are open to girls in Years 12 and 13 and can be held for a maximum of two years, reviewed annually.

The Fees Assistance Scholarship covers 50% of the annual tuition fees.

Description:

- The Fees Assistance Scholarship is advertised with other St Margaret's College scholarships and is available for new or existing Year 12 and 13 students.
- Applications close at **4pm on Friday 6 September 2019.**
- The Fees Assistance Scholarship is awarded at the end of October / early November
- The Fees Assistance Scholarship commences Term 1 the following year.
- Applicants are required to complete the Fee Assistance Application Form annually.
- Recipients will be required to provide written proof from official sources of ongoing financial need each year for the continuation of their Fees Assistance Scholarship.
- The Fees Assistance Scholarship will be deducted from the school fee invoice.
- All financial information provided by the applicant will be confidential.
- The recipient may remain confidential if required.

Criteria:

- Descendant of an Old Girl – daughter, granddaughter
- Financial hardship
- Year 12 or 13 student (new students subject to roll availability)
- Contribution to their current school
- Attitude
