**2020 FEES AND CONCESSION RATES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

International students need a student visa to study in New Zealand. The annual tuition and boarding fees must be paid before the College can issue the documentation required for visa purposes. These fees are non-refundable.

**ACCEPTANCE FEE:**

An acceptance fee of \$2,000.00 is required once a place is offered.

If the student does not take up the place, no refund is payable.

(including Building Fund, Parents' and Friends' Association subscription)

**INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE LEVY (Years 12 & 13)** (incl of gst) \$1,500.00

**SUNDRY CHARGES:** \$2,000.00

Our International students are encouraged to participate in at least one arts and one sports club during the year. This fee is usually sufficient to cover these costs although additional charges may apply during the year depending on the level of student involvement.

**ESOL:**

ESOL tutoring is included in the tuition fee for international students.

**INSURANCE:**

All international students will be required to arrange their own medical and travel insurance.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

1. One term's written notice of intention to withdraw the student from the College is required and all fees incurred over the notice period must be paid. Where no notice is given, a fee of one term's tuition and boarding fees will be charged in lieu of notice.
2. The Trust Board of the College meets each November to discuss any increases in the school fees for the following year. Information about fees for 2021 will be available from the Finance Office in early December.
